NOTES FOR INSTALLATION

1. Please ensure pipework is clear of debris by flushing lines prior to installation of the mixer body.






PRESSURE AND TEMPERATURE REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Inlet pressure range 100 500kpa
- 2. Maximum hot water temperature 60 C
- AS/NZS 3500 requires 500 kPa maximum operating pressure at any outlet within a building
- Hot & Cold inlets should have equalised water pressures.


STEP 1

- Based on the size of the body and the wall type, either secure it to the noggins or embed it into the wall at an approximate height of 1100mm.
- Ensure that the body is installed level, plumb and square.



STEP 2

 Connect the hot (LHS) and cold (RHS) supply and the mixed water pipe using applicable sealing practices. Remove the plastic tiling template and test for water security with the mixer in both open and shut positions, replace the template.




STEP 3

 Either, sheet around the mixer body with fibre cement sheeting or backfill the exposed channels ready for tiling.




STEP 4

 Ensure tiles are cut as close to the plastic template covering the mixer dome as possible; remove the plastic template after the tiling is completed.




STEP 5

Install the trim cover plate over the dome.



STEP 6

 Install the lever securing it with the grub screw provided.
